She will give her sermon, *"What Mischief Are We Gonna Do Next?"*, on Sunday, September 7. The title focuses on good trouble making in these times. The service begins at 10:30am and will include an ingathering water ceremony. A reception will follow at 11:45am. The church is located in downtown Rochester, at 150 S. Clinton Avenue, 14604.

Eileen Casey-Campbell (she, her, hers), who identifies as queer, is a Unitarian Universalist minister. She is a long-time resident of Rochester, NY, and graduate of Colgate Rochester Crozer Divinity School. Eileen served the Unitarian Universalist Church of Canandaigua, NY, for seven years, and her previous work is in youth and young adult programming as well as church growth and membership, first with the Episcopal Diocese of Rochester and more recently at First Unitarian Church in Rochester. She shares life with her partner, Brian, and their two children. She is a certified yoga teacher and birth doula, who is also particularly called to social justice work including LGBTQ+ activism and advocacy, creative worship, and ministry with youth and young adults. She engages in the spiritual practice of creative work with her own hands—making art, bread, gardens, and pottery.
